Wildwood Update

It is with sadness that we inform our members that Mat Zettler our Park Manager had a medical emergency November 26 and is still in hospital. We all wish both Mat and Joanne the very best and hope Mat gets well soon.

During Mat's absence we have hired Ian Rutherford to assist in park duties when Tony has days off. Ian will work two four hour days a week possibly more as needed.

The water diversion project that was begun almost three years ago is finally a go. The history on this project was we have 13 members sites that receive excess water from the farm property just outside the gate primarily from snow melt causing small rivers of water to run through members sites. The project will begin in the summer of 2021 with work being done both inside and just outside Wildwood This project is being split three ways, Municipality of Bluewater, Bill Dowson the farmer just outside the main gate and Wildwood.

In discussions with the Board of Health we have been told that we may use the rec hall to a maximum of 10 people. Masks must be worn while in the hall. Eating and drinking is now allowed with a maximum of 6 to a table, masks must be used at all times other than when drinking and eating. Currently Huron Perth is in the COVID orange zone but if we go to the red zone the 10 people allowed into the hall at any one time will be reduced to 5.

Paul Van Bakel has agreed to resume the balance of Linda Bowmans term as our Treasurer on Wildwood's Board of Directors.. Thank you Linda for your service and get better.

Our staff have continued to make improvements to our splash pad. A wooden deck has been built between the pool and the splash pad that looks great.
