## **STOVE POT ROAST WITH MASHED POTATOES**

1 (3 pound) beef roast

salt and ground black pepper to taste

4 (10.5 ounce) cans condensed beef broth

1 cup water

1 white onion, cut into large wedges

5 cloves garlic

1 (16 ounce) package carrots, peeled

1 sprig fresh rosemary

Mashed Potatoes:

5 pounds Yukon Gold potatoes, peeled and diced

1 (12 ounce) can evaporated milk, or as needed

½ cup butter

salt to taste

Season chuck roast with salt and black pepper; sear in a large, deep skillet or Dutch oven over medium heat until browned, about 10 minutes per side.

Pour beef broth and water into the skillet with roast. Arrange onion wedges and garlic cloves around the meat. Spread carrots atop roast and place sprig of rosemary atop carrots. Turn heat to medium-low and simmer until tender, about 6 hours.

Cover potatoes with water in a large pot and bring to a boil; reduce heat to low and simmer until tender, about 30 minutes. Drain. Mash potatoes with butter and half the evaporated milk until smooth; slowly mash remaining evaporated milk into potatoes to achieve the desired consistency. Season with salt.

Remove 1 or 2 cloves of garlic from skillet and mash cloves on top of the roast; serve with mashed potatoes.

It should take us the day, so please have your hoses disconnected from the taps if at all possible. If you have not winterized your trailer, I strongly advise you do it by this time.

Leaf pick up has finished for the year, no additional pick up will be done until the spring. I would like to say a big thank you to Brenda Campbell and the late Darcy Cleaveley for their help with this year's pick up. It is a huge task and your help was greatly appreciated.

As some of you are aware Ian has moved on, and I would like to thank him again for his 7 years here at Wildwood. I will start interviewing in late March, early April, as work will begin in early May. For High School students, it will be weekend work, until the school year is finished. This

is a great position, as if we are happy with the quality of work, it can be extended unto future years, just like Ian's tenure here.

As we all are well aware Mother Nature, is all over the place, and power outages are occurring on a more frequent basis. I would ask members at this time, if you are here in the park during an outage, please **DO NOT FLUSH YOUR TOILETS**. By doing so you are putting a strain on the pumping stations, which could lead to backups and over flow, as the pumps do not have the power to work. Also if the power is off for more than 20 minutes, and we lose pressure in the well tanks, a Precautionary Boil Water will be in effect until we have the water tested. The results can take up to 10 days to receive back from the lab. We have to do this as directed by the Health Board and the Ministry of the Environment.

Regarding members parking vehicles on Sunshine Sites & their neighbours sites instead of their own site & on grass...please park on your own site or in the parking lot in front of the rec hall, thank you.
